

# 2021 Player Consent

As the parent(s)/legal guardian(s) of the above child(ren), I/we give my/our approval for said child(ren) to participate in any and all TBJFC organization activities, including transportation to and from the activities. I/We understand that participation in TBJFC organization activities may result in serious injuries and/or bodily harm and that protective equipment does not prevent all injuries to players. I/We hereby waive, release, absolve, indemnify and agree to hold harmless the TBJFC organization, each and all of their Officers, Members, Sponsors, Participants, Coaches, and persons transporting my/our child(ren) to and from activities for any claim arising out of any injury to my/our child(ren) and myself, however caused, during the course of any and all TBJFC organization activities, including, but not limited to, practice sessions, games, and/or travel to said activities.

I/We hereby give my consent to have the Coach, Assistant Coach, Officers, Members to act as my surrogate to have an athletic trainer and/or doctor of medicine or dentistry provide my child(ren) with medical assistance and/or treatment until such time as I can be contacted in the event of an accident, injury, sickness, etc. This care may be given under whatever conditions are necessary to preserve the life, limb, or well-being of my child(ren).

Parents/guardians are responsible for ensuring their child is collected at the field immediately following his/her session.

By signing up to participate in the TBJFC organization, I/we agree to abide by the club's CODE OF CONDUCT and acknowledge that the club may use and/or allow to be used photos or other media for coach and/or promotional activities.

Payment is required in full prior to the player(s) being registered and allowed to practice.

# 2021 Spring 7 on 7 Flag Football Parents / Legal Guardians Code of Conduct

## WHO THIS WAIVER IS FOR:

All parents/legal guardians of children enrolled in Tahoma Junior Beers 7 on 7 Football for the Spring 2021 season. You are required to read and agree to the Code of Conduct terms below.

## PARENTS / LEGAL GUARDIANS CODE OF CONDUCT

- I/We will remember that children play sport for their enjoyment not yours.
- I/We will applaud good performances and efforts by my child and their team. Congratulate both teams upon their performance regardless of the result.
- I/We will consult with the Coach on all issues surrounding questions about my child's performance in practice and in games. (If there is no resolution, I will consult the Board)
- I/We will encourage my child to participate, I will not force them.
- I/We will focus on my child's efforts and performance rather than winning or losing.
- I/We will encourage my child to always participate according to the rules and Coaches instruction.
- I/We will never ridicule or yell at my child for making a mistake during practice or a game.
- I/We will demonstrate appropriate social behavior by not using foul or abusive language, harassing players, coaches or officials.
- I/We will respect official decisions. If there is a disagreement, I/We will follow the appropriate procedure in order to question the decision and teach children to do the likewise
- I/We will remember that children learn best by example. I/We will applaud good plays by all teams.
- I/We will show appreciation of volunteer coaches, officials and administrators. Without them your child could not participate.
- The consumption of alcohol and smoking is prohibited on any field TBJFL uses.

- I/We understand that if my child becomes a safety risk to himself or others, the Coaches will inform us of the situation. The first is a verbal warning, the second is a week's suspension from practice and game, and the third could be removal from the program. (To be voted by the Executive Board)
- I/We understand that when called upon, it is my/our responsibility to volunteer at home games for various needs of the organization. This includes but not limited to; concessions, apparel, grill, chairs, video, photos, press box, score keeper, announcer, etc.
- Unless communicated, ALL required equipment will be turned in at the end of the season. In addition to forfeiting your deposit, TBJFL has the right to bill parties for not turning in ALL required equipment to include safety equipment and jerseys/pads.
- I/We understand that my/our child must be fully equipped for every game with all of their football gear. \*TBJFL may consider a cost for items supplied during a game or practice\*
- I/We understand that football practice is not a "drop off" service and that we need to be 100% reachable at all times during any event.
- I/We will professionally address all issues with the Head Coach and if it is not resolved we will take the issue to the Board to address. \*Note: It is strongly recommended that all correspondence be delivered in person before or after practice and never during a game unless it is a violation or safety concern.
- TBJFL and its supporters have the right to remove any individual from an event if there is a perception of a safety violation or unsportsmanlike conduct.

**If any of these rules are not adhered to the following consequences will be upheld:**

1. Verbal warning from the Athletic Director and President.
  2. Written notice of violation (if duplicated) signed by the Athletic Director and President
  3. Terminated from the program. (To be voted by the Executive Board)

# 2021 Spring 7 on 7 Flag Football Player Code of Conduct

## WHO THIS WAIVER IS FOR:

All Football players and/or Cheer athletes for the 2017 - 2018 season. You are required to read and agree to the Code of Conduct terms below as applicable to your registration designation.

## FOOTBALL PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

- I will play for the “fun of it” and not just to please parents and coaches.
- I will play by the rules.
- I will never argue with an official. If I disagree, I will have my Coach approach the official during a timeout or after a play.
- I will work equally hard for myself and our team. My team’s performance will benefit and so will you.
- I will be a good sport. Cheer all good plays whether by my team or the opponent's team.
- I will treat all players as I would like to be treated. I will not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player.
- I will cooperate with my coach, teammates and opponents at all times.
- I will have fun and be a good sport (win or lose).
- I will place the emotional and social concerns of my team ahead of my personal desire to win.
- I will be honest, fair and always demonstrate good sportsmanship to all coaches, players, officials, parents and fans at all games, practices and related events.
- I will learn the value of commitment to the team. I will attend every practice and game that I can, and will notify my coach if I cannot.
- I will put personal goals aside for the betterment of the team.
- I will show courtesy and respect to teammates, opponents and coaches.
- I will realize that athletic contests, including practice sessions, are educational experiences and opportunities.
- I will not engage in unsportsmanlike conduct to include walking off the team, fighting, throwing items, arguing, or bad mouthing another teammate or opponent.

- I will not engage in rude behavior that could negatively impact the team, system or program.
- I will treat everyone, including coaches, parents, players and officials, with respect, regardless of race, creed, color, nationality or gender.
- All persons associated with Tahoma Jr Bears Football League are expected to avoid conduct detrimental to the integrity of and public confidence in the Tahoma Jr Bears Football League Organization. This requirement applies to all players, coaches, parents and other volunteers in TBJFC.

**If any of these rules are not adhered to the following consequences will be upheld:**

1. Verbal warning from the Athletic Director and President.

  3. One week suspension to include the game. (To be voted by the Executive Board)
  4. Terminated from the program. (To be voted by the Executive Board)
